The Southern University Laboratory School Homecoming Committee is busy preparing for this year's Homecoming events. The Homecoming Committee is requesting your assistance in making this year's parade the best ever. We are inviting you to enter and be a part of the Homecoming Parade. Our theme this year is "101 Years- The Beginning of a New Era".

The SULS Homecoming Parade this year will take place on September 21, 2023, at 1:00 PM. Float and car decorating can begin at 8:00 AM in the parking lot. The parade lineup will be at the F.G. Clark Activity Center/ Mumford Stadium. All participants are expected to arrive and line up beginning at 9:30 AM.

The parade will begin traveling west on Harding Blvd. The parade will then turn right on E.C. Harrison, and turn left on Jessie N. Stone passing in front of the campus bookstore. The route will continue on Jessie N. Stone, and turn left on Roosevelt Steptoe Ave. passing in front of the Law Center. The parade will turn left on G. Leon Netterville Dr., and pass in front of the J.S. Clark Administration building. The parade will continue back to Harding, and make a left on E. C. Harrison. The parade will then make a right on Jessie N. Stone by T.T. Allain, and turn right again onto Robert E. Smith Dr. The parade will make its final turn onto Swan Ave., and end in front of Southern University Laboratory School. Any late arrivals will not participate in this year's parade.

Rules and Regulations

- An entry includes 1 unit.
 - No additional vehicles, including but not limited to cars, vans, and scooters. Marchers will be allowed to accompany registered units. The only exception to this is vehicles pulling floats/trailers.
- All drivers must possess a valid vehicle operator's license and be adequately trained to drive their assigned entries.
- All entries must be properly insured.
- All entries must provide their own candy/ throws for the duration of the parade.
- Chaperones must accompany children on top of cars.
- Beware of children along the parade route as they may run and jump for candy. Kids are likely to approach units without regard for safety.
- Individuals are not allowed to jump on or off of moving units at any time nor should individuals hang onto moving units. Spectators from the crowd are not allowed to join the parade line-up.
- All parade participants must conduct themselves acceptably and respectfully.
- Music with vulgar and explicit language is prohibited.
- Socially acceptable attire must be worn during the parade.

Failure to comply with these rules and regulations will prohibit parade participation and/or abrupt dismissal from the parade line-up. Participants are expected to be on time for the line-up which begins at 9:30 AM.
